

Apprenticeship Compensation – Painter

Painter Apprentices have the option of a 100-hour vacation and are considered U.S. Craftworkers. They do not receive personal holiday hours.

1st period 1560 hours –60% prevailing rate

2nd period 1560 hours – 70% prevailing rate

3rd period 1560 hours – 80% prevailing rate

4th period 1560 hours - 90% prevailing rate

5th period of 1560 hours - 100% prevailing rate

Painter Apprentices are treated as US Craftworkers/trades. Apprentices will receive all Craftworker/trades pay plan increases on the effective dates, with retro pay if needed.
